2007 MAGNUM Betz Family Cellars, La Serenne Syrah, (RP 94 for 2006 Vintage)

The 2007 Syrah La Serenne is the Betz interpretation of Hermitage. The wine is 100% varietal from the Boushey Vineyard located in Yakima Valley. Opaque purple-colored, it offers enticing aromas of mineral, earth, crushed stone, pepper, and blueberry jam. This is followed by a massive but seamless wine with superb blue fruit and blackberry preserve flavors. This well-balanced effort has a finish which seems to go on and on.

2007 MAGNUM Betz Family Cellars, La Cote Rouse Syrah, (RP 95 for 2006 Vintage)

The 2007 Syrah La Cote Rouse is 100% varietal sourced from two vineyards. Purple/black in color, it offers up an array of aromas including bacon, sausage, spice box, smoke, pepper and tar - reminiscent of a Guigal La Landonne. Dense, layered, and opulent, this powerful effort should hit its peak by 2015 and provide pleasure through 2030.

2007 MAGNUM Betz Family Cellars Besoleil Grenache, (RP 93 for 2006 Vintage)

The Rhone portion of the portfolio begins with Betz's take on Chateauneuf du Pape. The 2007 Besoleil is composed of 75% Grenache, 13% Syrah, and 12% Mourvedre. Dark ruby/purple-colored, the wine exhibits a splendid bouquet of garrigue, black cherry, and spice box. It offers a silky texture, layered sweet fruit, great concentration, and a 60-second finish. The quality of Washington's Grenache is still a secret but, with wines like this, that won't be the case for long.

2005 MAGNUM L'Ecole No. 41 Winery, Apogée, Bordeaux Blend, Pepper Bridge Vineyard, (RP93)

The 2005 Apogee Pepper Bridge Vineyard is 45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 7% Malbec, and 3% Cabernet Franc. Saturated purple-colored, it has a slightly brooding nose of pain grille, pencil lead, spice box, and assorted black fruits. It is the most structured of the L'Ecole reds with darker fruit and greater aging potential.

2005 MAGNUM Leonetti Cellar Reserve (RP 97)

The 2005 Reserve is made up of 63% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Petit Verdot, and 17% Merlot. It was aged in new French barriques and a large oval botti for 22 months. Deep purple-colored, the wine presents aromas of pain grille, pencil lead, scorched earth, black currant, plum, and blackberry liqueur. The wine makes a powerful entry onto the palate with great concentration, serious depth, and opulence. The flavors reveal spicy, savory black fruits with a note of chocolate in the background. Long and complex, this superb Reserve is another tour de force for Leonetti Cellar.

1987 Imperial (6-L) Whitehall Lane Winery, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley (RP 88)

An excellent, outstanding Cabernet Sauvignon, Whitehall Lane's 1987 possesses a dark ruby/purple color, as well as sweet, jammy, cassis fruit, an appealingly thick texture, and no hard edges. The acidity, tannin, and alcohol are all well-integrated in this seamless, opulently-styled Cabernet Sauvignon.
